Covid 19 Safety Update (June 17, 2021)

As many know by now, Vermont recently surpassed an 80% vaccination rate for 16-year-olds and older allowing Governor Scott to lift restrictions.

Terrific news, yes...**BUT**, it is essential to remember that the Tyler Place has a children's camp embedded in our midst and the safety and protection of unvaccinated children and partially-vaccinated young teens is the responsibility of **all** families. We take this very seriously and ask that those of you with older children impress upon them this reason for our safety policies that may be different from what they have experienced at home.

Are PCR tests still required within three days of your arrival?

Yes, for anyone in your family attending the resort who is not vaccinated.

Do we need to show PCR test results?

Yes. PCR tests need to be taken and results uploaded to your Dashboard within 3 days prior to your arrival.

Do we need proof of vaccination?

No. But we do ask that you verify on your Dashboard the vaccination status of each member of your family who has been vaccinated. Otherwise, we will expect a PCR test.

Are masks still required outdoors?

In general, guests do not need to wear masks outdoors. However, we encourage all those not fully vaccinated (including children) to wear a mask when in sustained close proximity to others.

Are masks still required indoors?

Policy for Adults & Young Adults: Masks for vaccinated adults and young adults are not required indoors—with the exception of at the buffet (see below.) However, masks are required indoors when in close proximity to children.

Policy for Junior Moppets through Senior Teens: For specific information pertaining to mask wearing policies, please refer to your Check-In Information (sent by email) a week prior to your arrival.

Family Afternoon Activities: Masks are not required at outdoor family group activities except for when your children are in close proximity to other children. Masks for all unvaccinated guests are required at indoor family group activities.

Note: Dining Room Buffet Change

With restrictions lifted, the Dining Room Buffet will operate as it has in the past, but we are requiring masks for everyone as they go through the buffet line as an extra precaution for safety and sanitation.

We'll continue to update you as your arrival draws near.
