Covid 19 Safety Update (May 3, 2022)

In our ongoing effort to provide as safe a vacation as possible, we have taken into account current guidance and added simple layers that we believe give an extra level of comfort to all, while also retaining the fun, relaxed Tyler Place vacation experience. The efforts we made last year to more fully utilize the outdoor space on the property will remain in place. As will our enhanced cleaning, sanitization and handwashing protocols. Regarding vaccination, testing and masking, below are some specifics on where things stand presently (though, subject to change depending on any updated guidance or protocol adjustments recommended at the time of your stay).

Vaccination & Testing

Guests 16 & Over:

As you know, we are requiring **all guests 16 and over to be vaccinated against Covid-19**. You can now upload a photo of your vaccination cards on your Dashboard, under the 'Forms' section.

Guests Under 16:

In order to add an additional layer of safety, we are asking that for all family members under 16, (and over 2.5 years old) you provide proof of vaccination OR a negative PCR test taken within 72 hours prior to your arrival at the resort. Whichever is applicable can be uploaded via your dashboard.

Our entire staff will also be vaccinated.

Masking

We continue to monitor guidance from the State of Vermont as well as other health agencies and will base any indoor masking decision on the information available at the time of your visit. That said, at this point you can expect masks to be welcomed and supported, but not required. Because so much of the Tyler Place experience for children and adults takes place outdoors, we are optimistic that if any masking is required at the time of your stay, it would be limited.

As many of you know, each week at the Tyler Place is its own close-knit community of families, and all our decisions are focused on making your week as safe and fun as possible. We appreciate everyone's diligence in doing their part as well to help ensure the health and safety of all within that community.
